About this Policy

The UTRCA's Seasonal Camper Reduced Fee & Refund Policy is intended to maintain good relations with current and prospective patrons, as well as ensure consistency and clarity when providing refunds. If you have any questions about the policy, please contact our Conservation Area staff and discuss it with them directly.

From May 1st to May 20th

Seasonal campers may request a refund of their seasonal camping fees, minus the daily camping fee for each day since the season began. The Reduced Fee & Refund Schedule shows the refund available during this time.

After May 20th

After May 20th, there will be no seasonal camping fee refunds under any circumstances. There will also be NO refunds for sewage pumping services or for additional vehicle passes.

Evictions

Please note that **no refunds** are available at any time as a result of seasonal campsite eviction(s).

Selling Your Trailer?

If you sell your trailer and the purchaser becomes a new seasonal camper in a UTRCA Conservation Area, the purchaser will not be charged a seasonal camping fee unless the seller has received a refund for seasonal fees paid. A \$200 administration fee will be applied to the new camper, to enable our staff to complete all the tasks associated with the transition.

Your sewage services and any winter storage payments can be transferred to the new camper, upon request.

Additional vehicle passes and swipe cards are non-transferable and must be returned at the time of the site surrender.

New Campers

New patrons who become seasonal campers after May 20th will receive a reduced fee. Please see the Reduced Fee and Refund Schedule for the reduced seasonal fee schedule for this year.
