Per Ontario Public Pools Health Regulations:

- All bather must shower with warm water and soap before entering the pool at all times.

## **Aquatic Swim Admission Standard**

- All children aged 0-5 (zero to five) must be accompanied in the water by an adult age 16 (sixteen) or older, who is responsible for the child's direct in-water supervision by being within arms' reach at all times, at a ratio of 1 (one) adult to 2 (two) children 5 (five) years old and under. NO EXCEPTIONS. The Lifeguard on Duty and all Wildwood staff will enforce the Aquatic Admission Standard at all times.

- All children 6-9 (six to nine) who do not successfully complete the swim test must be accompanied in the water by an adult 16 (sixteen) years of age or older, who is responsible for the child's direct in-water supervision and remains within arm's reach at all times, at a ratio of 1 (one) adult to 4 (four) children under the age of 9 (nine). Parent/guardian must remain in shallow areas of the pool where they can comfortably stand. NO EXCEPTIONS. The Lifeguard on Duty and all Wildwood staff will enforce the Aquatic Admission Standard at all times.

All children 6-9 (six to nine) who complete the swim test may access the pool unaccompanied; an adult 16 (sixteen) years of age or older must remain within the pool enclosure and directly supervise their children, at a ratio of 1 (one) adult to 8 (eight) children under the age of 9 (nine). Direct supervision is defined as aving visual and verbal contact at all times, and able to render immediate assistance at all times. NO EXCEPTIONS. The Lifeguard on Duty and all Wildwood staff will enforce the Aquatic Admission Standard at all times.

-All children 10 (ten) and older may access the pool unaccompanied. Swimmers of any age may be asked to complete the swim test at the discretion of the Lifeguard on Duty. Based on swim ability, restriction to shallow water may be made.

## Facility Admission Swim Test

- Child must jump in and tread for 60 seconds, swim two widths of the pool, with their face in the water, using arm and leg action, without stopping or pausing movement during the entire swim. Child must demonstrate this to the Lifeguard on duty who will make the final decision on the child's ability.
