We hope you have had a great camping season! It was wonderful to have our pool and special events back after the long COVID period. Please read this newsletter for important information as we head into the fall.

Off Season Storage and Reservations for 2023

Wildwood Conservation Area closes on Sunday, October 16 at 12 noon and the gates to the campground will be locked. All campers leaving a trailer, deck, and/or shed in the park over the 2022/2023 off season must sign a winter storage agreement and make payment at the front gate or registration office before the park closes.

Winter storage fees are:

- Trailer Storage (includes deck and shed): \$350
- Shed/Deck Storage (trailer removed): \$175

Win FREE Winter Storage!

Seasonal campers who pay for winter storage by September 30 at 4 pm will be entered into a draw to win FREE winter storage! Anyone who has already made their payment will be automatically entered.

Preparing for the Off Season

Please disconnect your electrical cord from the pedestal as well as your water hose. The only items that may remain on your site for winter storage are:

- trailer
- shed
- deck
- fire pit
- affixed awning/ gazebo
- wood box

Any other items remaining on site (including on your deck, under the deck or trailer, or chained/attached to a tree, shed, or trailer) will be disposed of at the site permit holder's expense. Staff will begin documenting and removing items as soon as the park closes. Staff are not responsible for any damages caused to items such as cables, cords, satellite dishes, and wires buried on site, by off season maintenance tasks.

When cleaning up your campsite, please remember that we provide garbage and recycling for household bags only. We DO NOT accept oversized items.

Yard waste should be placed at the Waste Management Centre. Please remove the waste from any non-compostable bags. DO NOT place yard waste in any other location. Piling leaves, etc., along the edge of or within natural areas smothers native species and spreads non-native plants. Wildwood is home to some rare species close to the edge of the campground. Help us protect these species by putting your waste in the area provided.

Note that electricity and water will be shut off on Sunday, October 16 at 12 noon when the park closes.
